

Oral Book Report Guidelines

ORAL BOOK REPORTS WILL BEGIN ON TUESDAY, MARCH 16.
THE WRITTEN PART OF THE REPORT WILL BE DUE ON 3/16, AS WELL.

For this report students will need to:

- dress up as one of the characters in the story and tell about the book from that character's point of view ("Hi, I'm Willie Wonka and I'm going to tell you what happened in Charlie and the Chocolate Factory."). REMEMBER TO STAY IN CHARACTER WHILE GIVING THE REPORT.

- If your child reads an autobiography or biography, they still need to dress up as that character or as another important person from the book.

-Students should think of it as a book chat, it should last about 2-3 minutes. Like a book chat, students should be able to tell the title and author of the book. They should state what character they are portraying, as well as touch upon some of the main events of the book. Where does the story take place? Was there an important event or conflict? How was the conflict solved?

In addition, students will have to write a short paragraph, no less than five sentences, summarizing what happened in the story, as well as draw/color an illustration. SENTENCES SHOULD NOT BE NUMBERED.

Students should be prepared. See grading rubric. ***Book reports turned in late will receive a lower grade.***
