Spelling Sentences: Spelling sentences are due Tuesday and Wednesday. Every parent letter will contain the weekly spelling list. Students will also be given a copy of the list. The spelling list will be taken from our spelling book and will contain 15 words. Sentences for #1-7 are to be turned in on Tuesday. Sentences #8-15 will be turned in on Wednesday.

A student may choose to turn in all 15 sentences on Tuesday, but may not turn them in late (i.e. waiting and turning all 15 in on Wednesday). Students must use the correct heading on their handwriting sheets. Each list word must be used once in its own sentence and should be underlined.

*The reading rainbow will almost always be the back side of the parent letter unless otherwise noted.

Tests/Quizzes: Religion quizzes will be scheduled mostly on Thursdays. Fridays are reserved for spelling and reading tests.
