ATHLETIC DIRECTOR DUTIES

- ◆ Facilitate monthly board meetings.
- ◆ Securing F.C. for all practices and games
- ◆ Attend ALL league/parish meetings (approx. 16 throughout school year)
- ◆ Assist commissioners with sport evaluations
- ◆ Communication between league and commissioners/parents
- ◆ Help and support commissioners to ensure sports run smoothly. Game Set-up, supervision, score-table help, clean-up, sending in scores, etc.
- ◆ Gym set-up/supervision when hosting league events
- ◆ Liaison between S.P. and Mt. Carmel when they use F.C. as their home facility
- ◆ Acting sport commissioner when there is no current commissioner to run sport
- ◆ Oversee all sport registration process, get info. out to parish community. Weekly sports page updates for school newsletter.

- ◆ Create & Maintain Practice Schedules
- ◆ Maintain Positive Contact/Communication with Coaches
- ◆ Attend all Scheduled Meetings (St. Pius & PPSLeague)
- ◆ Communication with League/Coaches for Game Changes
- ◆ Weekly Communication with League (calling in game scores)
- ◆ Gym/Field Supervisor for all Home Games
- ◆ Secure "off-site" Track & Field Practice Location
- ◆ Coordinate end of Season Evaluations
